<b>Reporting To</b>	Director of Lifesaving

## Position Overview

The Lifesaving Equipment Officer has overall responsibility for the care and maintenance of the Club's patrol radios and rescue boards and tubes.

This role liaises with the Director of Lifesaving to ensure availability and currency of radios to meet patrol needs.

The Lifesaving Equipment Officer will assist with the preparation of the annual budgets to ensure worn or damaged equipment is replaced.

## Operational Objectives

Responsible for the correct use and care of all radio equipment, including charge station. This includes ensuring that:

- correct procedures and regulations governing radio usage are adhered to.
- all radio equipment is maintained and repaired in a timely manner.
- Adequate working radios are available for efficient and safe operation of the Club's patrols.

Responsible to ensure that adequate rescue boards and rescue tubes are maintained and available to meet the Club's patrol obligations and rescue training requirements:

- Arrange for repair and replacement of damaged equipment when required.
